Who is really changing?

HEBREWS 13:8 NKJV – (8) Jesus Christ *is* the same yesterday, today, and forever.

This text may well be taken as our motto in looking forward, as I suppose we are all more or less doing, and trying to forecast the dim outlines of the coming events of this New Year. Whatever may happen, let us hold fast by the confidence that, 'Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, and today, and forever.'

The instructions and examples of ministers, who have honorably or dishonorably closed their testimony, should be particularly remembered by survivors. And though their ministers were some dead, others dying, yet the great Head and High Priest of the church, the Bishop of their souls, ever lives, and is ever the same. Christ is the same in the Old Testament day, as in the New Testament day, and will be so to His people forever, equally merciful, powerful, and all-sufficient. Stay focused on Him!

Also, know this. God has given you and I a purpose! He has no favorites! So let us stop saying 'Well, He is/was an Apostle; He is/was a Prophet' or otherwise making excuses of why we are not qualified! Jesus Christ *is* the same yesterday, today, and forever. All people in the bible had issues, but God used them. Are you willing?

Lastly, are we changing for the best or has the worst ever left us. Either way, Jesus Christ *is* the same yesterday, today, and forever.
