## The End: It Will Take Place

**REVELATION 22:11 NASB** – (11) Let the one who does wrong, still do wrong; and the one who is filthy, still be filthy; and let the one who is righteous, still practice righteousness; and the one who is holy, still keep himself holy."

One of the biggest challenges I face is knowing that not many are sharing the truth about Christ. The Discipleship process does not seem to be in affect as should be.
