An Ordered Life

PROVERBS 29:16-27 NLT - (16) When the wicked are in authority, sin flourishes, but the godly will live to see their downfall. (17) Discipline your children, and they will give you peace of mind and will make your heart glad. (18) When people do not accept divine guidance, they run wild. But whoever obeys the law is joyful. (19) Words alone will not discipline a servant; The words may be understood, but they are not heeded. (20) There is more hope for a fool than for someone who speaks without thinking. (21) A servant pampered from childhood will become a rebel. (22) An angry person starts fights; a hot-tempered person commits all kinds of sin. (23) Pride ends in humiliation, while humility brings honor. (24) If you assist a thief, you only hurt yourself. You are sworn to tell the truth, but you dare not testify. (25) Fearing people is a dangerous trap, but trusting the LORD means safety. (26) Many seek the ruler's favor, but justice comes from the LORD. (27) The righteous despise the unjust; the wicked despise the godly.
