The Blessings of Jesus

JOHN 21:25 NLT – (25) Jesus also did many other things. If they were all written down, I suppose the whole world could not contain the books that would be written.

Only a small part of the actions of Jesus had been written. Let us bless God for all that is in the Scriptures, and be thankful that there is so much in so small a space. Enough is recorded to direct our faith, and regulate our practice; more would have been unnecessary. Much of what is written is overlooked, much forgotten, and much made the matter of doubtful disputes. We should look forward to the joy we shall receive in heaven, from a more complete knowledge of all.

Jesus did and said, as well as of the conduct of his wisdom and grace in his dealings with each of us. May this be our happiness. These are written that we might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing we might have life through his name.

The Apostle John is responsible for the writing of this book. His sole purpose for writing this gospel was to show that Jesus is "The Son of God." In this book he clearly and systematically presented the evidence for Jesus claims. When evidence is presented in the courtroom, those who hear it must make a choice. Those who read the Gospel of John must also make a choice – is Jesus the Son of God, or isn't He. You are the jury. The evidence has been clearly presented. You must decide. Read John's Gospel, believe and experience the "Blessings Of Jesus".
