There was a woman with the issue of blood (**Luke 8:43-48**). Four men bring a paralytic to Jesus on a mat (**Mark 2:1-5**). Now a man who was lame from birth was being carried to the temple gate called Beautiful, where he was put every day to beg from those going into the temple courts (**Acts 3:2**).
