## **A Brighter Day is Coming**

**PSALM 30:5 NASB - (5)** For His anger is but for a moment, His favor is for a lifetime; Weeping may last for the night, But a shout of joy comes in the morning.

Ministry can be challenging and there will be times when you will shed tears due to what you see going on in the world. Sometimes you feel like you are not accomplishing anything. People treat you as if you are nothing!. It can really beat you down physically, mentally and sometimes spiritually. The thing that helps me is remembering that who I am and who's I am!
