Relating to "The" one

MATTHEW 6:24 KJV – (24) No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

JOSHUA 24:15 KJV – (15) And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.

1 KINGS 18:21 KJV – (21) And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, how long halt ye between two opinions? If the LORD be God, follow him: but if Baal, then follow him. And the people answered him not a word.

Referencing to the top scripture (Matthew 6:24), unless our spiritual perspective is directed by God, we will wonder in the dark. Few things can distract our spiritual focus and fill it with darkness as effectively as becoming a slave to money. Note that having money is not the problem, though. The danger is when money has you. This is when the physical becomes more important than the spiritual. You can't serve two masters. You will love one and hate the other. God must have our devotion if you are to receive His kingdom direction. Joshua and Elijah make it clear that who you choose to serve decides who your God is and / who you can relate to the most. We have a sin nature, but the God we serve will teach us how to correct our wrongs. Only one can do that.

When we choose the true and living God, we will relate to "The" right one.
