REVELATION 22:18-19 NKJV – (18) For I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book; **(19)** and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the holy city, and *from* the things which are written in this book.

The Apostle John makes his point very clear when he states that, "If men add to the things written in this book of Revelation, they will suffer the plagues described in it." Since the subjects in this book are woven throughout the Bible, the verse, in effect condemns any tampering with God's word. A similar judgment is pronounced on anyone who takes away from the words of this prophecy. This does not apply to minor differences of interpretation, but an outright attack on the inspiration and completeness of the Bible.

DEUTERONOMY 4:2 NKJV – (2) You shall not add to the word which I command you, nor take from it, that you may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you.

2 TIMOTHY 3:16-17 NKJV – (16) All Scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, ¹⁷ that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

His word has been written. His word is complete, infallible, nourishing, with wisdom and understanding that only comes from above.
