WEEKLY MINISTRY MEDITATIONS

## A Worship At His Level

**WORSHIP** – Reverence toward a divine being or supernatural power, the human response to the self revelation of the triune God. This includes (1) divine initiation in which God reveals Himself, His purposes, and His will; (2) a spiritual and personal relationship with God through Jesus Christ on the part of the worshipper; and (3) a response by the worshipper of adoration, **humility**, submission, and obedience to God.

To be humble, one would demonstrate an attitude of not being prideful, haughty or arrogant. Though their position or status may be well known, this person chooses to rank low in a hierarchy or scale. He or she worships with a servant attitude full of love and caring. Jesus demonstrated this in the following verses.

**JOHN 13:4-5** NIV – (4) so he got up from the meal, took off his outer clothing, and wrapped a towel around his waist. (5) After that, he poured water into a basin and began to wash his disciples' feet, drying them with the towel that was wrapped around him.

The above verses introduce the account of the foot washing in particular. For the love that is evident in the laying down of life at the crucifixion is also demonstrated in the laying down of life in humble service in the foot washing. In the foot washing we have "an acted parable of the Lord's humiliation unto death."

Who is washing feet? Jesus our Lord, our Savior and our Teacher. People who consider themselves humble, should always worship at His level.
