## **Doing Your Part**

**EXODUS 14:15-18 NLT** – **(15)** Then the LORD said to Moses, "Why are you crying out to me? Tell the people to get moving! **(16)** Pick up your staff and raise your hand over the sea. Divide the water so the Israelites can walk through the middle of the sea on dry ground. **(17)** And I will harden the hearts of the Egyptians, and they will charge in after the Israelites. My great glory will be displayed through Pharaoh and his troops, his chariots, and his charioteers. **(18)** When my glory is displayed through them, all Egypt will see my glory and know that I am the LORD!"

**LUKE 17:12-14 NLT** – **(12)** As he entered a village there, ten lepers stood at a distance, **(13)** crying out, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" **(14)** He looked at them and said, "Go show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were cleansed of their leprosy.

**2 KINGS 4:2-6 NLT** - **(2)** "What can I do to help you?" Elisha asked. "Tell me, what do you have in the house?" "Nothing at all, except a flask of olive oil," she replied. **(3)** And Elisha said, "Borrow as many empty jars as you can from your friends and neighbors. **(4)** Then go into your house with your sons and shut the door behind you. Pour olive oil from your flask into the jars, setting each one aside when it is filled." **(5)** So she did as she was told. Her sons kept bringing jars to her, and she filled one after another. **(6)** Soon every container was full to the brim!

The power of God and the blessings of God are already in affect. He has done what is necessary for me and you. What is missing is your taking initiative in, "Doing your Part." Look at the three scriptures above. Notice the instructions underlined. The people who received the instructions did their part to make the task complete and to see God receive the glory! What is it that God said He would do for you and actually has, but He is patiently waiting for you to do your part? Could it be simply to be obedient? Could it be to simply to put more effort into reading, studying and applying His published book, instead of all those other none important books? You make the determination and once you have come to the conclusion, "Do Your Part!"
