# When is Enough, Enough? (Pt. 2)

**JEREMIAH 15:6 NIV – (6)** You have rejected me," declares the **LORD**. "You keep on backsliding. So I will reach out and destroy you; I am tired of holding back."

Last week, I shared the point of the meditation. This week, let us break down what is taking place in each sentence of the above verse...

- <u>"You have rejected me," declares the LORD....</u> His worship, as the Targum; and had set up idols, and idol worship; and this was the cause of the sword, pestilence, famine, and captivity, and of all the evils that befell them:
- <u>"You keep on backsliding"</u>.... From the law of the Lord, and from His pure worship and service, from His ways and from His ordinances; and therefore, it was but just that they should go into captivity; hence, it follows....
- <u>"So I will reach out and destroy you"</u>.... His hand of power and vengeance, which when stretched out and falls with weight, whether on particular persons or on a nation, brings inevitable ruin and destruction with it....
- <u>"I am tired of holding back"</u>.... Not that the Lord ever changes His mind, nor the counsel of His will in this sense, He is without repentance; but the conduct of His providence, and the dispensations of it, not executing the threatening denounced but sparing them a little longer-showing mercy, and exercising patience and longsuffering; but, now He was as one weary and tired out, and was determined to bear no longer with them, but stir up all His wrath against them, and destroy them.
