

SOUL THE FEAR OF BEING ALONE

1 KINGS 19:10 NKJV – (10) So he said, “I have been very zealous for the LORD God of hosts; for the children of Israel have forsaken Your covenant, torn down Your altars, and killed Your prophets with the sword. I alone am left; and they seek to take my life.”

Church history is filled with examples of those who stood alone for God at risk to their own lives. Standing alone can be a frightening experience. But all who stand alone for Christ do so because they have confidence in God’s promise never to forsake His own.

We may never be called upon to stand alone for God in the face of death. But even in the face of criticism, or being hated or ridiculed for our faith, we can stand firm because God stands with us.
