

GOD OPENED MY BLIND EYES

JOHN 9:39-40 NKJV - (39) And Jesus said, "For judgment I have come into this world, that those who do not see may see, and those who see may be made blind." (40) Then some of the Pharisees who were with Him (Jesus) heard these Words, and said to Him, "Are we blind also?"

Have you ever wondered why some of God's people always seem to have a valid excuse, as to why they don't study His Word? Some say, it's because they frankly don't understand the language written. So, why does the Bible recommend that His servants 'study' if the information given is hard to understand? A wise servant can see, such a one can't comprehend Spiritual things because of blindness.

When someone is blind in a matter, he/she lacks understanding; having a false sense of security. Once the individual asks for guidance, he/she avails himself to be secured, and to see (understand) 'Truth' again.

The real issue of blindness comes when the truth of a matter is not addressed; and that truth continues to be locked up in 'fear' of the unknown. Concealed, until that fear is presented to the proper authority. Once addressed, fear makes an about turn unto 'Faith'...then that Faith is revealed as 'The Truth'. Through the truth of God's Word, we gain the ability to know more about His plan for us; His Word 'opens the eyes' of our understanding to His sovereignty, to His providence and His Love as His servant matures more and more in the perfection of His Will.
