PSALM 119:15 NKJV – (15) I will meditate on <u>Your</u> precepts and contemplate <u>Your</u> ways.

In the next to the last verse of this stanza, the psalmist continues to his resolutions for how he will store God's Word in his heart and guard his way with it. Just as he has determined to declare and delight in the Scriptures, now he focuses upon his need to meditate upon God's precepts.
