They Won't Get Away!

2 PETER 2:4-10 NASB – (4) For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into hell and committed them to pits of darkness, reserved for judgment; (5) and did not spare the ancient world, but preserved Noah, a preacher of righteousness, with seven others, when He brought a flood upon the world of the ungodly; (6) and if He condemned the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah to destruction by reducing them to ashes, having made them an example to those who would live ungodly lives thereafter; (7) and if He rescued righteous Lot, oppressed by the sensual conduct of unprincipled men (8) (for by what he saw and heard that righteous man, while living among them, felt his righteous soul tormented day after day by their lawless deeds), (9) then <u>the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from temptation</u>, and to keep the unrighteous under punishment for the day of judgment, (10) and especially those who indulge the flesh in its corrupt desires and despise authority Daring, self-willed, they do not tremble when they revile angelic majesties,

Some actually believe there is a perfect crime. Why? Because man hasn't identified the culprit. My brothers and sister, God knows everything! We won't get away if we don't come clean with God and repent. Don't focus on others, but instead observe yourself! Don't just have the mindset that His grace is sufficient "well He has died for our sins." This is true, but should we abuse grace? As Paul said in the book of Romans, may it never be. Don't use the line, "God knows my heart." God says it is wicked! He should know. He knows everything. As for His mercy, it is like a water faucet, one day it will be shut off.

Don't take chances, instead repent, for the kingdom is at hand! To repent means to have a change of mind. Know this, **we will not get away with anything**!
