MATTHEW 14:30 NASB - (30) But seeing the wind, he became frightened, and beginning to sink, he cried out, "Lord, save me!"

Prior to Peter crying out to Jesus for help, he believed that he could do it (walk on and out of his circumstances), but his power was his to do such a task. He said Lord, "If it is you." So many of us don't even recognize our Father's identity. Nevertheless, we step out because of what we think we know, see and even watch others perhaps do.
