# Stand Up and Represent

As children of God, we must stand tall and firm at all times! God's military is always sharp! Through the Holy Spirit, God equips us with the finest. We are human, but we do not volunteer in stumbling and we do not <u>entertain</u> foolishness! God has blessed his troops with the gift of discernment. If it is not something God would not think about, if it is something God would not speak or even act out on. <u>Stop entertaining it</u>. Remember, if you entertain something not of God even an inch, you are inviting an inch of negativity into your heart (mind). One will unintelligently say, "I can handle it". Without God (totally), we are nothing! He has called us to be pure in heart. It does not mean we are perfect, but remember, we are in this world, but not of it.

#### So stand up and represent!

As children of the most high God, we must be delivered from people! We are either for God or against Him. (<u>That means no carnality or double mindedness</u>). We have been warned about hypocrisy.
