

## WHEN WE IGNORE THE WARNING DECEMBER 9, 2024

**ROMANS 1:18-19 NKJV – (18)** For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, **(19)** because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown *it* to them.

**ROMANS 1:24-32 NKJV** – (24) Therefore, God also gave them up to uncleanness, in the lusts of their hearts, to dishonor their bodies among themselves, (25) who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen. (26) For this reason God gave them up to vile passions. For even their women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature. (27) Likewise, also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust for one another, men with men committing what is shameful, and receiving in themselves the penalty of their error which was due. (28) And even as they did not like to retain God in *their* knowledge, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not fitting; (29) being filled with all unrighteousness, sexual immorality, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, evil-mindedness; *they are* whisperers, (30) backbiters, haters of God, violent, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, (31) undiscerning, untrustworthy, unloving, unforgiving, unmerciful; (32) who, knowing the righteous judgment of God, that those who practice such things are deserving of death, not only do the same but also approve of those who practice them.

For years we have heard, learned, participated or even saw sexual activities that were evil before the sight of God. Allow Him now to clean us up. Confess before Him. Let us repent of our actions. Let us repent! When we ignore the warning, be prepared for the sentencing mentioned in the above scriptures.
