PSALM 25:1 ESV - (1) O LORD, you are my God; I will exalt you; I will praise your name, for you have done wonderful things, plans formed of old, faithful and sure.

God has always had a remnant of believers who trust His word and believe His promises and give glory to His name - even when the experiences of the life and the ungodly behaviors of others seem to indicate the reverse.

Isaiah was here warning of the coming great day of judgement – the great ‘Day of the Lord’ and ‘Time of Jacob’s Trouble’ – the coming tribulation period, when God will pour out His wrath on a Christ rejecting sinful world. But even in that terrible seven-year period, which will follow the any-day rapture of the Church into heaven, Isaiah writes of a little remnant, that will bow their knee to the Lord and lift up their voices in joyful praise and worship to God, singing: O LORD, You are my God; I will exalt You; I will praise Your name, for You have done wonderful things, plans formed of old, faithful and sure.

It was just the other day I thought to myself or God brought to my attention that I have made it through the last two years without experiencing a deadly disease called “COVID.” I have tested and tested to make sure all is well because I am working around others or just among people and not one time did I attract this virus. I am not any better than any other human when it comes to this virus but I must praise Him! This alone compared to the things, the million and million of things I don’t even know about.

Therefore, you as well also have an “Unending Praise” that you must give God! There is also the one who has experienced the demise of a friend, family member, etc. It may sound selfish but it isn’t. If the one who has transitioned has received Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior then again there is room for that “Unending praise!”
