The Ministry Of Discipleship (Pt. 1) (There is work to do)

DISCIPLE – One who helps spread another's teachings.

There is only two teachings that one could spread. That is the doctrine of Christ or the doctrine of Satan. Now that we know that we work for Christ, let us never forget that *His teachings are powerful!* Satan has no power at all!!

MATTHEW 28:16-18 NKJV – (16) Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, to the mountain which Jesus had appointed for them. (17) When they saw Him, they worshiped Him; *but some doubted.* (18) And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "*All authority* has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

We teach accurately when we teach as Christ did. This means through our actions and through our speech. Our biggest problem is moving forward and doing what Christ has commanded.

MATTHEW 28:19-20 NKJV – (19) *Go* therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, (20) teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age."

Look around you. Look at the negativity taking place in this world. Many of us claiming Christianity are participating in the negativity. This means we possibly followed the wrong teachings. Do not put it off anymore! Either you are a pupil or a disciple. Either way, "*There Is Work To Do.*"
